When we received the call to participate in Project:Unity, we could not say no!

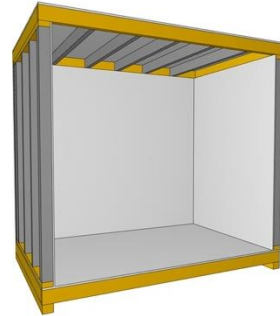

Modularity

Balbek Bureau's original design is based on the fundamental pillars of modularity. We decided to take the previous design and modularize it even further. The walls and the floor are assembled separately. These finished sections are then joined together to form a complete module.

In this way, it is possible for small businesses to build and donate a section and thus also be a part of the project RE:Ukraine .

Our goal is to help as many people in Ukraine as possible. Therefore, our vision is that the project will not end with our current modules! With the increasing modularity, more modules can be transported on one truck and thus more modules can be brought to Ukraine in one trip. This will increase the interest of companies to participate in the project.



Our concept is to combine durability with modular timber construction. Durability for us is the provision of a stable module so that, in the event of a prolonged war, people will have a dignified alternative home during that time.

Modularity means that homes can be built quickly and assembled by non-professionals.

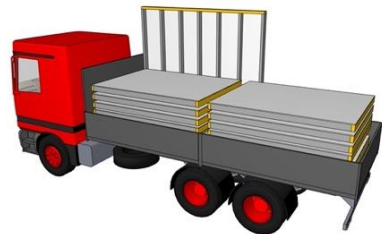
